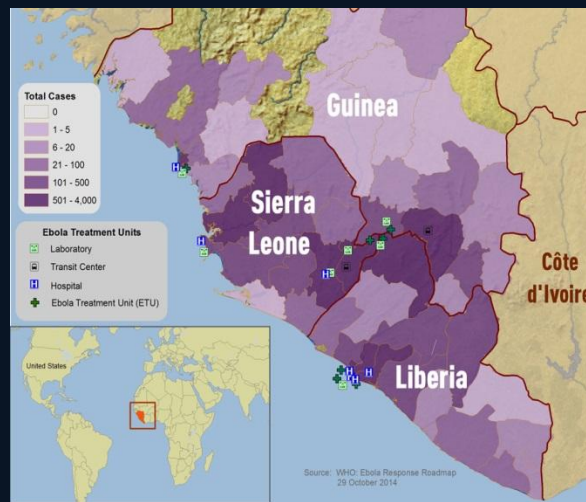

- LHD guidance for the assessment and monitoring of persons potentially exposed to Ebola distributed

- 4 trainings for laboratory sample packing and shipping scheduled for November

Community outreach:

- Continuing active community outreach with LHDs with larger West African populations
